
LEASE APPROVED FOR HICKORY ISLAND FIRE STATION



The newly proposed site for a fire station on Hickory Blvd, a two-unit store front at 26107 Hickory Blvd., has been given the stamp of approval by the majority of the Board of Fire Commissioners and construction is set to begin on July 1st.

First in, Nelson Marine will outfit the preexisting dock with a new boat lift which will allow for easy access to the Bay and Gulf for the BSFD Marine Unit. Soon to follow will be the construction of the firefighters quarters within the 850 square foot leased space.

This location comes as a sigh of relief after many years of searching and waiting for a proper site for a fire station on Hickory Blvd. This address will allow for faster response times to emergencies in the surrounding areas and will provide residents with a local crew of three firefighter-paramedics and/or firefighter-EMTs, a fire-rescue apparatus, and a marine unit. The location is ideal for dramatically reducing the response times, allowing the BSFD to provide a better service to the residents in the area.







PUBLIC FACILITIES AND OPERATIONAL REPORT

Chief Daigle presented the requirement for the report to the Fire Commission at June's Fire Board

Meeting. The report, mandated by Florida State Statue, identifies the best locations for Stations, and evaluates our current fire and ems deployment models, types of personnel, and staffing levels. The independent research company tasked with completing this report, will be familiar with State laws and will rely on NFPA and ISO national standards to evaluate the Bonita Springs Fire District's performance.

months from the commencement of their research. "This report is specifically meant to evaluate our ability to provide fire control and rescue services as an independent fire district." Chief Daigle explained, "Being an independent fire district, the State sets the standards. The report will assist in determining if the fire district is capable of responding to emergencies adequately.
