Over The Counter FIRE Permit Application

- This OTC permit applies to existing fire alarm and fire sprinkler systems only.
- While plans are not submitted when applying for this OTC permit, the contractor must keep a copy of the plans and specifications at the worksite and make such plans and specifications available to the Fire Inspector at each inspection.
- Inspections are **REQUIRED** for all over the counter permits.
- **FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS PROJECT** is defined as an alteration of a total of 20 or fewer initiating devices and notification devices, or the installation or replacement of a fire communicator connected to an existing fire alarm control panel in an existing commercial, residential, or multi-family complex. (effective 07-01-2022 under Florida State Statute 553.7932)
- **FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEMS PROJECT** is defined as an alteration of a total of 20 or fewer fire sprinklers in which the sprinklers are of the same K-factor and located in spaces where there is no change of hazard classification or increased system coverage area, or the installation or replacement of an equivalent fire sprinkler system component in an existing commercial, residential, apartment, cooperative, or condominium building. For purposes of this paragraph, a component is equivalent if the component has the same or better characteristics, including electrical, hydraulic, pressure losses, and required listings and spacing as the component being replaced. (effective 07-01-2023 under Florida State Statute 553.7932)
