Chairman Lohan called the meeting to order at 4:03 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The executive session was opened at 4:04 p.m. and was not open to the public.

Ms. Stoker read aloud the minutes of the August 12, 2019 executive session. Commissioner Murphy asked for two corrections to be made: changing “publicity reasons” to “public relations” and removing “but refused to go higher than 2.66/2.66/2.66.” No other changes were requested.

Chief Daigle shared with the Board a salary survey of the “South 6” conducted by Florida Gulf Coast University.

Chairman Lohan remarked that there should be more emphasis on contract Article 27 (Longevity Pay) because longevity pay is already built into the contract and negotiated raises are in addition to that.

Regarding Article 18, Commissioner Kosilla proposed a 9% raise over three years (3/3/3). After some discussion, the Board unanimously agreed to approve the proposal.

The regular meeting was reopened at 4:43 p.m. and the meeting adjourned.
